It is our goal to make dance classes accessible to all. With this in mind, FRCBA is pleased to be able to offer a limited number of work-study and scholarship opportunities. These will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve, demonstration of need basis. Work-study and scholarship recipients are expected to uphold the values and expectations of FRCBA and to set a positive example for other students. They are expected to maintain exemplary attendance and to arrive on time for class and rehearsal, participate fully, follow hair/dress code, and be attentive and conscientious during class. Failure to uphold these expectations may result in the withdrawal of work-study or scholarship support.

Work-Study

Each hour of work-study contributes an equivalent of \$12.50 towards tuition. Duties will be assigned upon discussion with the FRCBA Director and may include cleaning, monitoring the door and waiting room area, caring for any children who may need it, costume organization, production assistance, and administrative assistance work. If you have other skills that may be useful to FRCBA that you would like to offer as work-study, please let us know and we will consider their inclusion.

Scholarships

We have a limited amount of scholarship money to dispense to students in need each year. If work-study is not an option, please apply for a scholarship and explain the reason(s) that work study is not a possibility. The amount of scholarship potentially awarded will be a portion of the monthly tuition for the student in need.
